

## 4.0 SUMMARY

---

The Rouge Park Management Plan sets out an approach to delineate the limits of Rouge Park through the application of a set of criteria. This Implementation Manual was prepared to provide guidance on the delineation of the Park boundary by providing a description of the criteria and the process to be applied to facilitate their applications. The boundary delineation process requires the undertaking of “desk top” studies, field inventory and consultation with the province, municipality and Toronto and Region Conservation Authority.

The boundary delineation criteria were developed based upon the vision, goals and objectives set out in the Rouge Park Management Plan (1994) and the Rouge North Management Plan and are focused on achieving the protection, restoration and enhancement of the Natural and Cultural Heritage resources within the lands designated as Rouge Park.
